






### John 3

#### Hebrews 1

"2 in these last days has spoken to us in **His Son**,

whom He appointed **heir** of all things, through whom also He made the world. 3 And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins. He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high;

4 having become as much better than the angels, as He has inherited a more excellent name than they. 5 For to which of the angels did He ever say, "You are Mu Son, Today I have begotten You?" And again, "I will be a Father to Him and He shall be a Son to Me"?"

## *Hebrews 1:2-5 (paraphrase)*

"God the Father put Jesus on assignment as:

- 1) the only begotten Son of God
- 2) the heir (Messiah) of God's promises,
- 3) the **creator** of God's world and its systems,
- 4) the revealer of God's nature,
- 5) the **operator** of God's plan,
- 6) the purifier of God's people,
- 7) the **sharer** of God's glory and honor,
- 8) being much better than the angels."

Jesus should not be ignored in that he is the heart of God's self revelation and the meaning of life.



- Jews believe that Jesus was an ethnic Jewish (false) teacher, and not the Messiah, born to a virgin (Mary), or the Son of God (divinity).
- Muslims believe that Jesus was the Messianic prophet of God and was born to a virgin (Mary), but was not the only begotten Son of God.
- Some critics believe he never existed and is only the figment of the imagination of the early Christian community.
- Many critics believe that Jesus was one of many Jews who claimed to be "Messiah" and most of what we know about the historical Jesus comes from Christian Gospels which are viewed as historically unreliable.




#### Philippians 2


