• Speak the truth lovingly.


• Suffer offenses graciously.


• Share material possessions willingly.

The point is what WE DO and why; not what is accomplished and how.



The lower 20% have 5% of the wealth	The 65°	The top 20% have 30% of the wealth.					










Competition without the cooperation and compassion of community is costly.





Promote public policies that address the problems behind poverty.


Isaiah 10

"1 Woe to those who make unjust laws, to those who issue oppressive decrees, 2 to deprive the poor of their rights and withhold justice from the oppressed of my people, making widows their prey and robbing the fatherless."

Laws that make divorce easy, quality education unavailable, personal responsibility hard, and rehabilitation for prisoners scarce are unjust.







10. Realize that "entitlement" hurts both the rich and the poor.

Leviticus 10:15

"You shall do no injustice in judgment; you shall not be **partial to the poor or defer to the great**, but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbor."

Creating a culture of dependence for the poor and entitlement for the rich does not build dignity or self respect for either.
