1. Our "faith / worldview" provides the CONTEXT of all understanding.

Making sense of what we see and experience has roots in and finds meaning through presuppositions that we embrace by faith.

Science is equipped to explain how things operate (secondary means) NOT how they originate (primary means) or why they exist (purpose or meaning)


#### Hebrews 11:3

✓ Why are humans so unique?


✓ Why do we long for more?

✓ Why do we die?




#### Hebrews 11:3

# 3. The material creation is an **EXTENSION** of the spiritual Creator.


Its vastness is to magnify the Creator's love for humanity - made in HIs image.



## 2. Invest in character development.

#### Ephesians 4

"15 but **speaking the truth in love**, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him, who is the head, even Christ, 16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by that which every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love."

- Expect circumstances to be labs for character formation.
- · Pray for wisdom and Kingdom priorities.
- Be an active part of the body of Christ.
