
#### Genesis 4

Faith is seen in the quality of our sacrifices.


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
# Heb.11:4-7 is a testimony of

What we make our greatest sacrifices for will reveal our functional Messiah.

- A "functional messiah" is whatever makes us feel secure, & significant.


#### Acts 17

"23 For while I was passing through and examining the objects of your worship, I also found an altar with this inscription, TO AN UNKNOWN GOD.' What therefore **you worship in ignorance**, **this I proclaim to you**. ... 26 and He (**God**) made from one, every nation of mankind . ... 27 that they should seek God, if perhaps they might grope for Him and find Him, though **He is not far from each one of us**; 28 **for in Him we live and move and exist**, as even some of your own poets have said, 'For we also are His **offspring**.' ... 30 Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all everywhere should repent."


Hamblin described D'Agostino as "an amazing woman" and revealed that the pair had never met before the collision.




Our behavior will reveal our faith.
