

Matthew 4:

lived out through Christian aliens in a hostile world as




Spiritual Seed the Love of God The POINT of 1 Peter thus far


We are called out of this world as God's chosen and sent back into this world as aliens

A Christian alien's response to a broken world:

Social injustice.

Political disfunction. Pandemic stress. **Economic insecurity.** Climate change.

The world of the Roman Empire in Peter's day

Economic injustice.

Institutional slavery. Disease and famine. Political disfunction. Religious persecution.

1 Peter 1

"22 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified (sanctified) your souls for a sincere love (phileo) of the brethren, fervently love (agape) one another from the

23 for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring (persevering) word (logos) of God. 24 For, "All flesh is like grass, and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers, 25 But the word (rhema) of the Lord endures forever." And this is the word (rhema) which was preached (evangelized) to you."

- · "deceit" deception
- · "hypocrisy" a false front
- · "envy" coveting that of another
- "slander" false and degrading witness
- "putting aside" Eph.4:22-24

As Christians we possess two conflicting natures.

Galatians 5

"16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. 17 For **the flesh** sets its desire against the Spirit, and **the Spirit** against the flesh; for **these are in opposition to one another**, so that you may not do the things that you please."

We must exercise our will in determining which of these competing desires will control our behavior.


Ephesians 4

"20 But you did not learn Christ in this way, 21 if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, 22 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you **lay aside the old self**, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, 23 and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and **put on the new self**, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth."

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1 John 4

"19 We love, because He first loved us. 20 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also."
