



1 Peter 2

"4 And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God, 5 you also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For this is contained in Scripture: "Behold, I lay in Zion a choice stone, a precious corner stone, and he who believes in Him will not be disappointed."

"7 This precious value, then, is for you who believe; but for those who disbelieve, "The stone which the builders rejected, this became the very corner stone," 8 and, "a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense"; for they stumble because they are disobedient to the word, and to this doom they were also appointed."

"9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 for you once were not a people, but now you are the people of God; you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy."

"11 Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul. 12 **Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles**, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation."

It is the resurrected (living) Jesus, not the dead martyr that is the heart of the Gospel.

1 Corinthians 15

"17 and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. 19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied."

1 Peter 2

"6 For this is contained in Scripture: "Behold, I lay in Zion a choice stone,


a precious corner stone, and he who believes in Him will not be disappointed."

Jesus is the rock upon which the church is built.


Ephesians 2:20-21

1 Corinthians 15


"1 Now I make known to you, brethren, the **gospel** which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand,...


3 For I delivered to you as **of first importance** what I also received, that Christ **died for our sins** according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He was **raised** on the third day according to the Scriptures,"

1 Peter 3

"15 but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with **gentleness** and **reverence**; 16 and keep a **good conscience** so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your **good behavior** in Christ will be put to shame.

17 For it is better, if God should will it so, that you suffer for doing what is right rather than for doing what is wrong."


Does this mean that we are:

"rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation,"


