

2 Corinthians 10:1-6

Matthew 13:24-29 Why did Jesus forbid the disciples from removing the weeds from the wheat? The weeds could be won over with love. They were not to judge others. The weeds just need to be understood. Removing the weeds may injure the wheat. The weeds have rights that need respect. The weeds would die on their own.

"I Now I, Paul, myself urge you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ - I who am meek when face to face with you, but bold toward you when absent! 2 I ask that when I am present I may not be bold with the confidence with which I propose to be courageous against some, who regard us as if we walked according to the flesh." True Apostles are Christ-like. In dealing with the sheep: Meek inwardly, Gracious outwardly. In dealing with the wolves:


