


## Romans 9:21

"But He does according to His will in the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of earth; and no one can ward off His hand or say to Him, "What have You done?"




## **Divine Providence is**



We know that God's creation extends beyond the physical cosmos to include "the ages" or history.


## Hebrews 11:3


"By faith we understand that the worlds (**ages**) were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible."
