- The Gospels do not explain the resurrection.
 The resurrection is what explains the Gospels.
- Sunday worship is a testimony to the central significance of Jesus' resurrection.
- The resurrection of Jesus was the major theme in Apostolic preaching.

Christ's place in heaven.

Hebrews 1:3

"When he had made purification of sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high."

The work of redemption is finished.

 We, like Christ, are to rest from the work in being reconciled to God.


"and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him."

- Some Christians believe that they have a "right" to live as "kings" with Christ HERE and NOW.
- Note that Paul says "we WILL reign" not that we now DO reign.

"21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in the one to come."

Christ's place in creation.

- This addresses a heretical belief that spirit beings (angels and demons) had great authority over life.
- The implications are that Jesus is not just the Lord of Christians or of some primitive culture but has authority over all creation for all time.

The Christian Gospel is the hope of the world.

 Note that the Apostles applied the implications of this to evangelism, not politics.

Christ's place in the church.

 The church is not just a holding place for believers, or an institution for worship and education.

It is God's kingdom community on earth, a light on a hill and a spiritual family of alien ambassadors.

- The Apostles' ethical teaching and social standards are given to the Body of Christ not the secular state.
- While Jesus is Lord of all it is only in the church that kingdom values are the rule because they start with the indwelling Holy Spirit.

"22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all."

Jesus must be a functioning head not just a figurehead of the church.

- The church community is not only the means of evangelism but its goal.
- Pastors are not princes ruling over a "kingdom principality" - they are undershepherds who serve the sheep.
- The church is both distinct from the state and also salt and light within it.




