





Signs of Spiritual death

Rejecting the reality of sin

- The root of our dilemma is spiritual.
- Our spiritual response to life shapes us.

2. Embracing the spirit of this age

- Our culture pressures us to define reality and make decisions as though God is not there.
- Our culture pressures us to see life revolving around us and our plans.

3. Indulging the passions of the flesh

• Being true to ourselves means following our passions and tolerating moral libertarianism.

Galatians 5

"16 But I say, **walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.** 17 For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please."

Our challenge

 This was our PAST but we all still struggle with some of these things.

Note that "death" to sin does not mean we are incapable of sinning.

Romans 6

"3 Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? . . . 11 Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus."
