"For we all stumble in many ways. If anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able to bridle the whole body as well."






The first priority in Paul's agenda for change in Ephesians is managing the

TONGUE.



Identity choice is critical to truth telling.

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Self talk is a critical step in truth telling.

Ephesians 4

Be careful what you say to yourself because your soul is listening.

The worst lies that we tell are the ones we tell to ourselves about ourselves and God. 15

Popular lies that we tell ourselves:

1. We are accepted by God to the degree that we are in compliance with His rules.

But: In Ephesians 1 we are told that all who are "in Christ" (by faith) are:

- chosen, adopted,
- redeemed,
- sealed with an inheritance.


Note: Paul does not exhort us to earn or obtain these things but rather to realize that we have them.

Popular lies that we tell ourselves:


- 1. We are accepted by God to the degree that we are in compliance with His rules.

- 80% of our lies are to promote or protect our image.



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






Satan's pack of lies:


- 1. We are accepted by God to the degree that we are in compliance with His rules.

 - They are probably preoccupied with what we might think of them.

How do we change?

- 1. It starts with the recognition of a clear vision of what "needs to" change.
