



Speaking must be synced with 1. Empathetic understanding. 2. Well managed fear & anger.






Three issues to lay aside and put on.

Ephesians 4

"25 Therefore, laying aside falsehood, speak truth, each one of you, with his neighbor, for we are members of one another. 26 Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, 27 and do not give the devil an opportunity. 28 Let him who steals steal no longer; but rather let him labor, performing with his own hands what is good, in order that he may have something to share with him who has need. 29 Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, that it may give grace to those who hear. 30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice. 32 And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.' 5


"6 Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned, as it were, with salt, so that you may know how you should respond to each person."

Managing the tongue was mentioned earlier as the primary **"body building" tool.**



What makes for "edifying speech"?

- 1. It is based on personal security through God's love in Christ.
- 2. It demands that we identify and refuse to reflect the world's values.
- 3. It builds relationships between people
 - grace respect / acceptance
 - timing "there is a season . . . "
 - customized for each person.
 - listening understanding.
 - empathizing shared feelings.




