

A superficial hope as shaped by the world.

> A protective shield from suffering.

Faith that a **loving God** would grant it. A "worry - whine" briefing



- Worry is what we do before our plans are frustrated and whining is what we do after.
- √ They are both tied more to hope and expectations than to faith and peace.
- √ Worry and whining don't help unless. they lead us to a renewed mind.

When God spoils our plans

James 4

"13 Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit." 14 Yet you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that." 16 But as it is, you boast in your arrogance; all such boasting is evil. 17 Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin."

"13 Come now, **you who say**, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit.""

1. Like Eve, we exercise freedom to make plans that we feel will prosper us and give us peace.

> "If you want to make God laugh, show Him your plans."

> > "Preparation is necessary, plans are dangerous."

Don't "lord it over" God's people (4:11-12) or God's plans (4:13-17).

2. Wisdom calls me to make peace with what I KNOW and DON'T know.

God does not anoint my circumstances so much as my response to them.

Temporal circumstances will come and go but my response to them will define my witness and destiny going forward.

3. Faith, is often trusting God in the dark rather than trusting Him to grant our wishes.


> God directs us. We don't direct God.

Common MISTAKES we make

- 1. We expect a road map but God gives us a compass.
- 2. We seek special revelation but God renews our mind.
- 3. We read the Scripture as a rule book or a crystal ball but God shows us Jesus.
- 4. We place our faith in faith but God reminds us that even the Demons believe (Jas.2:19).

4. Presumption (with or without faith) is sinful.

Faith is not a virtue if it is in the wrong source and for the wrong things.

Colossians 2:18

"Take care that no one keeps defrauding you of your prize (pass judgment against) by delighting in humility and the worship of the angels, taking his stand on **visions** he has seen, inflated (confident) without cause by his fleshly mind,"

"17 Therefore, to one who **knows** *the* **right thing to do** and does not do it, to him it is sin."

5. The clear principles and priorities of God's kingdom should guide us and not be ignored.

Major on majors, minor on minors.

- The Way of the Cross as taught and illustrated by Jesus and the Apostles.
- Don't let minor issues blind you from seeing the fundamental issues in theology, ethics, and ministry.

- 1. Looks like Uncle Sam, acts like mother nature, and keeps score like Santa Clause.

- 3. Defines "freedoms" and identifies "fears" in temporal, material, political, terms.
- 4. Commissions Christians to "make America great" by establishing a kingdom before its time and without its King.
- The American dream is to be God's kingdom on earth - liberty, justice, prosperity, security, & peace.

Remember

- √ God desires to save us but not our plans.
- √ God's plans give us a compass more than a road map.
- √ Satan is a promoter of hope in anything but God's plan.
- √ We too often view the fulfillment of our plans as the assurance of:
 - God's love for us
 - or affirmation of our faith.

A closing word

1. Prepare a response for when and if OUR expectations fail.

When God interrupts take it as a challenge to become wiser, stronger, and a brighter light to this world.

2. Concentrate on being faithful to values, and flexible with plans.

Conflict is an opportunity for an inner spiritual audit.

How can I develop realistic expectations?

- √ Start by thinking development and demonstration of Christian character and community as God's clear will.
- √ Focus on a Godly response more than knowing and working a detailed plan.
