



 - knowing the Bible
 - being religious
 - doing ministry





is:

- mirroring the heart and mind of God.
- being captivated by the Glory (beauty, goodness, and power) of God.

is:

- being separated unto God from the inside out.
- the incentive to be separated from the world's values.
- the integration of God's Spirit into our lives, making us one with Him and His church.

Paul's prayer echoes Jesus' prayer.

Ephesians 1

"15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you, and your love for all the saints, 16 do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him."



"Knock and the door will be opened, seek and you will find."



Ephesians 4

"11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ. . . . 15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him, who is the head, even Christ,"

Bringing people to know Christ is the principle mission of the church.

Consider

What do you pray for and expect from Christian worship & fellowship?

- Wisdom to know God more than comfort for this life.
- Truth that may be hard to hear and love that reflects Christ's priorities.

Philippians 3

"8 More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ, . . . 10 that I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; 11 in order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead."

Knowing Christ requires stepping away from other things.

Consider

It is hard to know God if you never really need Him except as fire insurance.

When you suffer loss this may be an opportunity to know God.

When you are materially blessed consider the challenge that it may be to keeping you from knowing God.

I John 4

"20 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also."

Knowing God means that we love those whom God loves.

Consider

If we do not love those whom God loves, we do not really know God.

> Seeking community with and through God's family is a path to

knowing God.

How do we Know God (in but not of the world) Watching and learning - We get to those who do. Abiding in the Vine - We get to

know God as we watch and listen to

- know God as we integrate His Spirit into every area of our lives.
 - Prayer & Worship We get to know God as we renew our lives through worship and prayer.
 - Service We get to know God as we engage with Him in His work.
